FAQS

How much is it?

In Memoriam is completely free to visit.

Do I need to book?

You don't need to pre-book a slot, simply turn up anytime between 9am and 6pm between 8-16 May.

Are there any facilities on site?

On Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 May, the Stable Yard Café at Aston Hall will be open for takeaways with a BBQ, from 11am – 4pm. Public toilet facilities will only be available during this period.

Will I be able to park?

Will Aston Hall be open to visit too?

Aston Hall will be offering take away refreshments on Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 May, but will not be open to visit.

Will I have to wear a face covering?
